School Sponsorships

Sponsor a Hearing-Impaired Child

Nyadire has a Hearing-Impaired Resource Unit that services H-I children from the entire province. Students learn the Zimbabwean Sign Language and also learn life skills such as arts



and crafts, market gardening, welding, fashion and fabrics, and carpentry. The opportunity to receive an education gives students an identity and voice, teaches self-reliance, provides meaningful purpose, and most importantly encourages friendships, values, and goals. The Hearing Innovations Program takes a stand against the negative social attitude towards those with special needs.
